Quick Guide to Members' Privileges and Responsibilities

There are three classes of regular membership: Active, Associate, and Honorary members. All members may participate in club activities and serve on committees.

Members are considered Active for their first five years. After five years of Active membership, they may request a status change to Associate. Active, Associate and Honorary members have specific responsibilities and privileges.

x			Attend at least six yearly meetings unless excused
x	x		Pay dues and other financial obligations
